Your application will not be processed until payment is received. If not paid in the 2 weeks, you will have to resubmit your application. Registration fee will increase if paid after June 1. Refunds will be issued until June 1, minus a \$10 processing fee.

You will be notified by email as soon as your application is received and processed. We have a limited number of spots available. If your application is not accepted, you will be notified and kept on a waiting list if you choose. Please contact us if you don't hear from us in a timely manner. Please note processing will take 1 week in most cases.

- Food items must be packed and labeled (samples may be served w/ approved valid health certificate)
- All exhibitors are responsible for sales tax on items sold (8.265% rate subject to be changed)
- Nevada Dept of Taxation "ONE TIME SALES TAX RETURN" form will be issued to all vendors
- Tax Forms must be turned in to the information table BEFORE exhibit tear down
- The following items are not permitted to be sold: Drugs, drug paraphernalia, sex items, weapons including but not limited to guns, knives, swords, bows and arrows
- Exhibitors must remain **OPEN** until the end of the event
- If it rains, we will reschedule.
- Withdrawal requests must be submitted via email to questions@pilsos.org by June 1, 2023 to receive a refund (minus \$10 processing fee). NO REFUNDS will be made after this date.
- "NO SHOWS" will result in non-participation in next year's event
- Booth assignments and set up instructions will be sent to you prior to the event
- We will not be responsible for loss, theft, or damage of any items you have brought to the show
